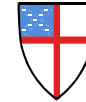

We welcome this morning the Rt. Rev. John L. Said and his wife Ann. Bishop Said was the Suffragan Bishop of the Diocese of Southeast Florida from 1995 until 2002. He served parishes in Indiana and the Diocese of Central Brazil and is a graduate of Berkeley Divinity School at Yale. He and Ann are parents of four children.
