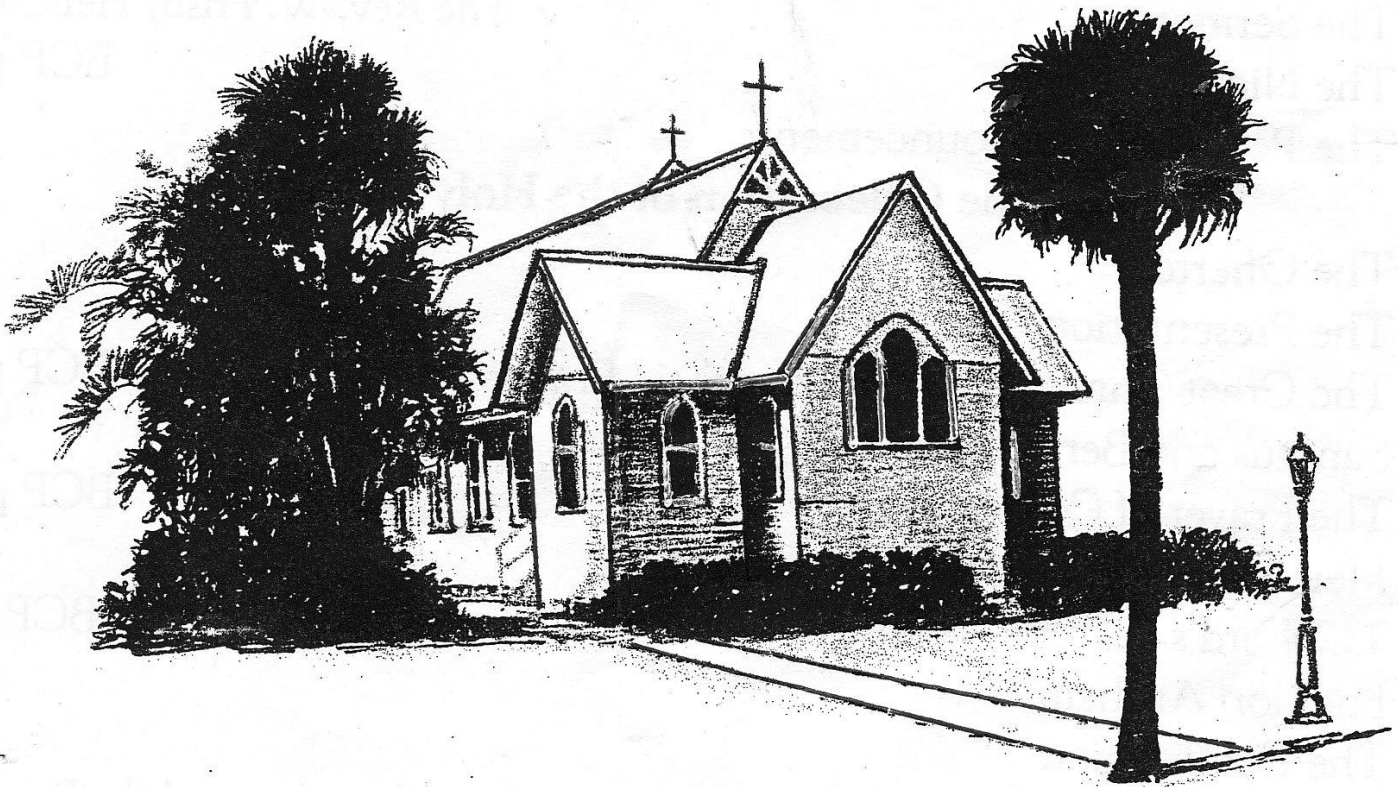

NOVEMBER 23, 1893 – NOVEMBER 14, 2010

During these pioneer years, the local Episcopalians held their monthly devotional services initially in private homes and at a later date in the schoolhouse. Bishop Gray's Diary tells us that on

“Thursday, November 23d [1893], we held service and I preached in a school house in Eden in the afternoon and at night. After service by the Archdeacon, I preached in the parlors of the hotel in Jensen.

I must say that the mosquitoes at these two places were something fearful. At the hotel the clerk comes out with a palmetto whip to clear the insects off the guests before hurrying him within the screened door. I went to bed with my face blotched and swollen by the multitude of bites... The great success of those who have settled here is drawing many others, and it is a very important field to look after.

I think lots will be given to the church in both places.” ii
