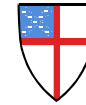

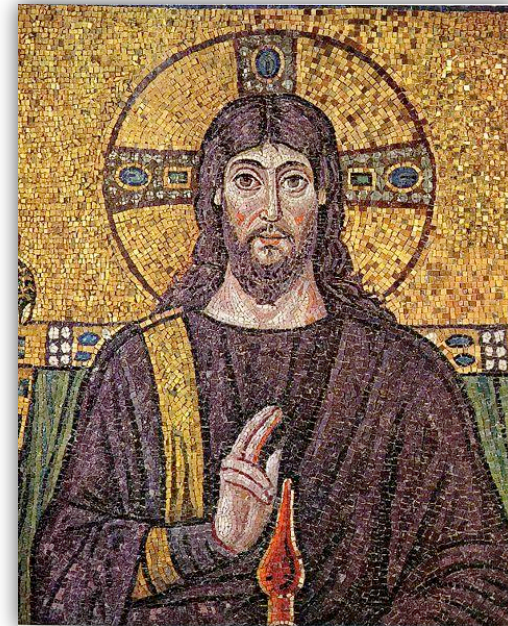

The Fall Convocation of North Palm Beach Deanery was held last Saturday at Holy Trinity Church, West Palm Beach, and attended by the Junior Warden, Treasurer, Vicar's wife and Clergy. The Rev. Carol Barron, Rector-elect of St. Luke's, Port Salerno, was elected the new dean and Carol O'Neil of St. David In The Pines, Wellington, was re-elected to the Executive Board. A resolution to provide voice and seat to Youth Coordinators of the Diocese was approved, as well as plans for the Annual Convention of the Diocese on November 7 and 8, 2008.
